This Political Sign Policy is an addendum to File No2362677 filed with the Gallatin County Clerk & Recorder June 7, 2010. This policy is pursuant to the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions for Meadow Creek Master Subdivision ("Covenants"), recorded in the real property records of the County Clerk of Gallatin County, Montana on June 7, 2010, Document No. 2362677.

Political Signs:

For the purpose of this policy, a political sign is either a sign which identifies a candidate running for elected office at the local, regional, state or national level who is on the ballot in either a primary or general election in the next scheduled election or it is a sign indicating a position on an initiative, referendum, or levy which is slated to appear on the ballot (primary, general, or otherwise) in the next scheduled election.

Political signs cannot be larger than 18"x24", cannot be placed more than 60 days prior to any election and have to be taken down the day after the election.

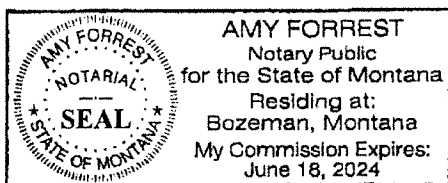
